Bedomin - Museum of the National Anthem

The former noble estate, where was born and lived Joseph Wybicki - author of the words of the Polish national anthem. Since 1977 the mansion is a seat of Museum of the National Anthem, explaining the song's history, so important for Poland. The museum also presents many exhibits of the Napoleonic era.



The most valuable collection of this institution are patriotic exhibits: songbooks and sheet music of Polish songs, words of other anthems modeled after the Dabrowski's Mazurka, different versions of the Mazurka from the nineteenth century. It is worth noting that this is the world's only museum dedicated to the history of the national anthem. Visit the school trip will be an excellent complement to Polish history lessons.

- Visit to the Museum of the National Anthem;
