

Bytow Castle - on the western borders the Teutonic Order

The fortress built in the years 1398-1405 was considered the most modern in the country of the Teutonic. To this day survived the three castle wings with the corner towers. Inside the old fort it is a museum of Western-Kashubian presenting many interesting exhibits of Kashubian culture.



The tour runs through the castle porches, halls, basements and cellars. The castle is particularly attractive during the summer months when the shows are often staged of knights fights and numerous concerts and outdoor events.

The tour plan:

- Visiting the Teutonic castle with a guide;
- Free time;
- On the way back - stone circles in Wesiory.
