Hel Peninsula – where Poland begins...

A trip to the Hel Peninsula discover the richness of this relatively little-known piece of Poland. During the tour you can see the dramatic course of military operations in September 1939, to feel the fishing specifics of Peninsula and finally convince with outstanding achievements in the field of nature protection in the Baltic...



It is worth mentioning here about Museum of Coastal Defence, which very interesting exhibits are exhibited in the bunkers of artillery batteries 'Schleswig-Holstein' - the largest such facility in the world! A great affection arouse happy seals, which the Baltic population by involving Hel research facility was saved from extinction. Interesting tour accent is visit at the end of the Hel Peninsula, surrounded on three sides by the waters of the Gulf of Gdansk and Puck.

The tour plan:

- The fortifications of the Defense "Jastarnia" – sightseeing;
- The Seal Centre - demonstration of medical training and feeding of seals;
- Free time;
- Visiting the lighthouse;
- Move to the headland Hel Peninsula;
- Visiting the Museum of Coastal Defence;
- Jurata - walk along the Bay of Puck (pier) and the Gulf of Gdansk.

The offer includes:

- Coach between designated locations;
- A licensed tour leader service on a route;
- Guide service in sightseeing places;
- Visiting the lighthouse and the Museum of Coastal Defense;
- Insurance.
