Pelplin - Sacral jewel of Pomerania

Pelplin - a small town in the southern part of the Pomorskie Voivodeship, located by the river Wierzyca. Almost the entire history of the place is associated with important sacred function. First, by a few hundred years officiated the Cistercians here, then in this small town was established the capital of the Diocese of Chelmno, and since 1992 operates here an independent center of Pelplin's Diocese.



Tourists amazes unusual accumulation of outstanding historical monuments. One such monument is the cathedral of the Assumption of Virgin Mary – this is the second largest brick church in Poland and inside you can see one of the largest altars in Europe! On a tourist route must also be found Diocesan Museum with a copy of the Gutenberg Bible – the only preserved in Poland. Interesting place is the The Pope Mountain - here the pope John Paul II celebrated Holy Mass.

The tour plan:

- Visiting the cathedral church;
- Visiting the Diocesan Museum;
- Climbing to the Mount John Paul II.
