

Slowinski National Park and ... dinosaurs

The theme of the tour is a visit to one of the most valuable natural areas in Europe. As such should be considered a complex of large, mobile sand dunes. Tour starts in the village Rabka, where a six kilometer route leads to the summit of Lacki Mountain. This is the largest moving sand dunes on the Polish coast.



Along the way viewpoints by the picturesque Łebsko Lake - the third largest in Poland. In the second part of the trip visit to Dinosaur Park, so a fascinating journey into the realities of the prehistoric world.

The tour plan:

- Moving along pathway from the Rabka village to the Lacka Mountain;
- Return by the seashore to the village Rabka;
- Transfer to Leba and free time;
- Visiting the Dinosaur Park in Nowecin.

The offer includes:

- Coach between designated locations;
- A licensed tour leader service on a route;
- Guide service in sightseeing places;
- Visiting the Slowinski National Park and Dinosaur Park in Nowęcin;
- Insurance.
