In Torun corners still is present the mood of the Middle Ages. After all, the local Old Town is perfect preserved Gothic urban layout - the uniqueness of this place has been underlined by entry on the list of UNESCO World Heritage Site. It's worth to see the Old Town Hall - the pearl of European gothic architecture, St. John church or the authentic Gothic houses.



In one of them was born (1473) a great astronomer Nicolaus Copernicus - inside the building completely devoted to this outstanding figure. The great popularity among young tourists has a Gingerbread Museum. There you will learn not only the secrets of making this fine delicacy but also yourself prepare and bake your own gingerbread!
