### **Cruises by stylized galleons**

A great wealth of Gdansk for centuries determined the proximity of the Vistula and the Baltic Sea. In this section, we suggest realization of events, which on one hand will introduce the interesting Vistula-Baltic issues, on the other will be an opportunity for a successful rest. Tourist traffic in Gdansk and Gdynia support stylized galleons, which in appearance are not very different from the seventeenth-century pirate ships.



We offer charter galleons cruise on routes:

- Gdansk – Westerplatte – Gdańsk - cruise through the shipyard and port areas and along the Westerplatte Peninsula, symbolic place of the start of World War II;
- Cruise through the Port of Gdynia - On the route e.g. gantry crane, one of the largest cranes in the world, port of the Navy and many other attractions.
- Cruise through the waters of the Gulf of Gdansk - during the trip very interesting views: Orłowski Cliff, Hel Peninsula and the Tri-City agglomeration;
- Cruise on the route Gdynia - Hel and back, by the waters of the Gulf of Gdansk. Hel is located at the end of peninsula, and is a town with a very interesting history. Possible going down from the vessel and a short tour of the town.
